When is Trick-or-Treating?

Saturday and Sunday, October 28 and 29, from 2 to 5 p.m.

How do I register for Trick-or-Treating?

Trick-or-treating registration is limited and requires a \$2 ticket that supports Colonial Williamsburg’s education and preservation initiatives.

Go to colonialwilliamsburg.com/haunting and add tickets for the adults and children in your party. When you check out, you will be required to provide credit card information. The \$2 ticket fee is per trick-or-treater.

You can also purchase tickets for special programs at the same time.

What do I do with my Trick-or-Treating confirmation letter?

Start by parking at the Colonial Williamsburg Regional Visitor Center. Inside, you can pick up the Mars Trick-or-Treating Bag and tickets for any other experiences you have ordered. Then, board the Spooky Bus for your trip to the Historic Area.

Can we bring our own bag for Trick-or-Treating?

No, candy will only be distributed to guests with the Mars Trick-or-Treating Bag provided with your registration.

Can I pick up my Mars Trick-or-Treating Bag and tickets in advance?

No. Mars Trick-or-Treating Bags can only be picked up the day of your registered ticket.

What do I do with my confirmation letter for other Haunting on DoG Street events?

Start by parking at the Colonial Williamsburg Regional Visitor Center. Inside, you can redeem your confirmation letter. **You'll receive tickets that will allow admission to your purchased program.** Then, board the Spooky Bus for your trip to the Historic Area and a meeting with Blackbeard as you get off the bus.

Where should I park? Is there a bus system?

Free parking is available at the Colonial Williamsburg Regional Visitor Center. A free "Spooky Bus" ride to the **Haunting on DoG Street** event is available and it will run until 11 p.m.
