

FAQ for Free Active Duty Tickets

- What is this program about?
 - Complimentary Admission is a tribute to the men and women of the U.S. armed forces including active duty military, reserve soldiers, airmen, Marines, sailors and Coast Guardsmen.
- What does it include?
 - Complimentary admission permits any U.S. active duty military, activated or drilling reservist, or National Guardsman to one complimentary admission per year to Colonial Williamsburg for military personnel and as many as three direct dependents. The offer is valid for one visit only.
- Do military retirees qualify? Civilians working for the Department of Defense?
 - Only U.S. active duty military qualify for the Honoring Service complimentary admission.
- Do reservists and National Guardsmen qualify?
 - Certainly. All active and ready reservists and members of the National Guard, regardless of deployment status, qualify.
- You offer a total of four free tickets. What if there are more people in my family?
 - You may purchase additional single-day tickets for direct dependents at a 50% discount.
- My spouse is serving overseas. Can dependents visit without their service member?
 - Yes, but this will use the service member's free tickets for the year.
- But I am a single parent serving overseas. My children are living with a relative. How can my kids visit?
 - The primary caregiver should visit the Colonial Williamsburg Visitor Center and they will make accommodations for minor dependents. Proof of military status and deployment is required.
- I am service member from an Allied country; does this program apply to me?
 - No. Program only applies to U.S. military members.
