We will send your child home a little dirty and a little tired, but inspired – and wanting more.”

The D.o.G. Street Adventurers Camp, recommended for kids ages 9-11 is offered in four sessions:

- June 25-29
- July 9-13
- July 23-27
- Aug. 6-10

The D.o.G. Street Explorers Camp, recommended for kids ages 12-13 is offered in four sessions:

- July 2-6

- July 16-20
- July 30-Aug. 3
- Aug. 13-17

Registration for each one-week session includes activity from 8:45 a.m.-4:45 p.m. Monday-Friday. Tickets are \$325 and include a camp t-shirt. Meals are not provided and campers are asked to please bring a lunch, snack and water bottle each day. Campers break for lunch from 1-2 p.m. Please notify Colonial Williamsburg of any special diet restrictions or allergies. Comfortable clothes suitable for outdoor activity, including closed-toe shoes are recommended.
